Department of Business Majors: or students with majors in the Department of Business, two courses (BUSA 505 Business Analytics and BUSA 501 Business Strategy and Exceptation) int toward both the undergraduate degree and the MB students in the 4+1 programme able to take two MBA coursins addition to BUSA 501/50 furing their senior year that will count only toward the MBA hese four courses (12 MBA credits) will allow students to complete 1/3 of the requirements for the MBA while an undergraduate student. The remaining 2 MBA credits are billed at the MBA program rate.

- *Students in this program must be registered for between \$2credits of UG degree requirements per semester during their senior year order totake 1-2 MBA courses without impacting UG financial aid.

- ***The fifth year does not have a residential option. It is fully online and you are considered a GRAD student.
- ****Even though you are accepteinto the 4+1 program with the completion of this form, you will need to complete a GRAD application during your senior year of UG so that you will make the transition to GRAD status after UG graduation.

Majors Outside the Department of BusinesStudents with majors outside of the Department of Business can also take advantage of the 4+1 MBA, completing 1/3 of the MBA requirementsuadengraduate student. For students with majors outside of the Department of Business, the recis mainor (Business Foundations) that provides students with an overlay to ensure that they are meeting the 4+1 MBA requirements. These students will be able to take an additional two MBA courses during their senior year that will count only toward the MBA. This will allow students complete 1/3 of the requirements for the MBA while an undergraduate students can also take some GRAD courses that conduct toward the MBA over the summer once they have achieved senior UG status.

*Students in this program must be registered for between \$2credits of UG requirementaring their senior year for their UG degree in ordertake 1-2 MBA courses without impacting UG financial and remaining 24 MBA credits are billed at the MBA program rate.
