Re: Compliance Responsibilities

We are required to annually remind you of the following:

Section 6311 of the Child Protective Services Law (enhanced by Act 153) requires all employees of any educational institution (including collegenduniversities) that has any students under the age of of 8 be mandatory reporters This means that if you have reason to suspect that a child is a victim of abuse, you must make an immediate and direct report to PA Childline by calle 09 932 0313. After making a report, you must also notify the University Department of Safety (from exampus: ext. 656, from off-campus: 717691-6005) which is responsible for coordinating the inversity's response and cooperation with authorities. If you are working with an Athletic camp, you must also immediately notify the U.S. Center of Safe Sport by calling 5200340. This responsibility to report applies to you both on and off the job. Willful failure to report suspected child abuse is exious crime and can result in misdemeanor or felony charge Please note the specific mandatory reporter training requirements for the following employees:
